## **Old familiars are doing well at KWPN Horse Days**

Last week during the KWPN Horse Days the VION Cup and the PAVO Cup were ridden. Both among the dressage and the showjumping horses there were a number of horses, auctioned in the past, that showed their metal.

Of the 5-yr-old dressage horses the mare Parabel (Westpoint x Don Schufro) managed to reach the finals. The 7-yr-old Bravo Liefhebber (Colino x Landon) finished second in the ranking and so obtained his starting ticket for the EC for Young Showjumping Horses in Lanaken. The stallion Edinburgh (Vleut x Darco) was referred to the performance test on the basis of his results in the 4-yr-olds category.

## **Everdale winner Pavo Cup**

Opinions of the stallion Everdale have been positive for some time but last week he fulfilled his promise by winning the Pavo Cup. Prinsjesdag National Foal Auction offers as many as three products of this talented stallion for sale. Everdale is combined with proven mares lines. If that

*17. Imperial de Baian (Everdale x Jazz). Everdale combined with the full sister of Parcival, d'Avance de Baian. d'Avance de Baian is elite-awarded and scored as many as 83.5 points for her IBOP. This mares line has produced a great many sport horses.*



*18. Impresario Texel (Everdale x Jazz). The dam of Impresario Texel is the provisionally keur- and prok-awarded Ellegantrasse Texel who finished 9<sup>th</sup> at the National Mares Selection. Also this family has produced several national and international sport horses.*



*19. Isis B (Everdale x Krack C). The dam of Isis B is the ZZ light level dressage horse Zenobia B, a half-sister of Wanda B (Jazz) and Pavo Cup finalist Charleston (Jazz). The Grand Prix mare Reine B is closely related to this mares line.*

## Casall time and again in the results

Rolf-Göran Bengtsson and Casall Ask have been a successful combination for many years and regularly finish high in the results of the biggest competitions in the world. Beginning of August the combination finished second in the Grand Prix of Ommen closely behind Mark Houtzager on Tamino. After two rounds in the EC in Herning, Denmark, the combination holds 4<sup>th</sup> place and claims 6<sup>th</sup> place on the world ranking. A proven sport horse, no question about it. Also the products of Casall are doing well in the sport. Three Casall products will be auctioned.



49. Felicity Nema (Casall x Carolus I). As a daughter of two Grand Prix parents Felicity Nema faces a fine future. Dam Ipanema jumped at Grand Prix level under Will Simpson (USA) and Harm Sievers (GER). The mares line is closely related to the stallions Clinton I, II and Levisto Z.



50. Cascoigne (Casall x Contender). Like last year we are offering a Casall foal for sale out of Zelda. Grandam Marli (Carthago) produced a national showjumping horse and is closely related to the stallions Creve Coeur and Chippendale.



51. Cascador (Casall x Lavaletto). Showjumping talent is anchored in the pedigree of Cascador. Dam Princess already produced 3 showjumping horses and great-great-grandam Gitta jumped at international level herself.
